If We Have Contacted You

You are reading this page as a result of receiving a letter and agreement from us, indicating that you may be entitled to an unclaimed asset. We hope this page will answer any questions you might have.

- **Why have you contacted me?**

We have contacted you as a result of research we have conducted, either following instructions from an attorney or in connection with a matter we have been researching on a contingency basis. Before we contact a claimant, extensive searches have been completed to determine that the person or firm is indeed a legitimate claimant. We do not pick names from a list or send mass mailings.

- **Are there risks to me and will I have to pay anything?**

We are entirely certain of your stake in an unclaimed asset. We are therefore willing to prove your interest at our own expense. As indicated in the agreement, there is absolutely no risk to you and if you receive no money we receive none as well.
